Free and Reduced Meal Eligibility Program



Program Description

Basketball Clinics

- The WDP Varsity Basketball coaches, staff, and players will provide instruction in fundamentals and drills at WDP High School and WDP Middle School.

League Play

- Fast Break teams will participate in the Bay Area Development League (BADL). Each league date consists of a team playing 2-3 games on a Saturday or Sunday.
- League play runs Nov – Feb.
- Schedules are set by BADL schedulers. Coaches will communicate league play dates/times/location when schedules are in place.

Tournament Play

- Home Tournament: All grade levels will play in the West De Pere Home Tournaments.
- Away Tournaments: All grade levels are eligible to play in away tournaments. Players must participate in the clinics and league play in order to play in tournaments. Each grade level has a maximum number of tournaments that a team can participate in. Once teams are formed, coaches will communicate tournament information.

Parent Responsibilities

- Attend MANDATORY parent information meeting. Dates and times will be communicated at a later date.
- Work a minimum of **FOUR HOURS** in concessions or other areas of need during home league and/or home tournament weekends for each child who participates in the Fast Break program.
