## Letter from Principal Young

Dear OLOL families,

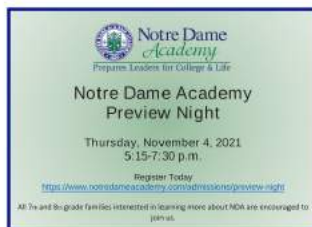


