Our Lady of Lourdes Dress Code 2023-2024

(revised July 2023)



Items that are not specifically addressed in the following dress code must have teacher or principal approval before wearing the item to school.

General Guidelines:

- Clothing should not be too tight or too loose
- Only OLOL logos are permitted on tops
- Belts are acceptable in brown or black
- Shirts may not be fastened or tied
- No hoods allowed on any uniform clothes
- November 1st through March 31st shorts, leggings, or tights must be worn under skirts, dresses, and jumpers unless temperature is forecasted to be above 70 degrees
- Undergarments should not be showing at any time
- Students must have a separate pair of athletic shoes for Phy. Ed. and these may be kept at school
- Scout uniforms may be worn on the day of meetings
- Athletic warm-up jerseys for OLOL teams may be worn on home game days
- Hats are only allowed on designated hat days
- These items are considered a distraction to learning or are a safety concern and are therefore not allowed:
 - Temporary tattoos
 - Drawing or writing on skin
 - Fashion scarves
 - Dangling/hoop earrings
 - Rips, cuts or tears in clothing
 - Neon colors in clothing
 - Hair that is unnaturally colored
 - Shoes with heels

Girls and Boys Uniform Attire – Grades K-8

Shirts - short or long sleeved polo or blouse with collar, turtleneck, or mock turtleneck in solid uniform colors

Pants/Shorts - relaxed fit chino style with pockets and belt loops insolid navy blue or khaki; shorts must extend past a student's fingertips when arms are against the side of the body.

Dresses/Skirts - skirts, jumpers, and polo dresses must extended past student's fingertips when arms are against the side of the body; skirts and jumpers in navy blue, khaki, and evergreen/white plaid; polo dresses in uniform colors; skirts, dresses, and jumpers must have bike shorts, leggings, tights underneath

Tights/Leggings/Bike Shorts - only worn under skirts or dresses in uniform colors or khaki

Socks - required to be worn and in uniform colors or black

Shoes - athletic shoes of any color; flat bottomed shoes or boots in navy blue, tan, brown, gray, or black; no sequins or light-up shoes; non-marking soles required; shoes must enclose the entire foot

Under Layers - short or long sleeve under layers in solid uniform colors; tucked in underlayer if it is longer than the outer layer

Outer Layers - sweaters, sweater vests, cardigans, and non-hooded sweatshirts in uniform colors; fleece may be worn in navy blue or black; collar must be crewneck or v-neck style; OLOL school apparel with the OLOL logo needs to be black, navy blue, or red; no hoods on any apparel

Hair - clean, well-groomed hair must be away from the face and above the eyebrows; plain headbands may have minimal decorations

Makeup - minimal makeup in good taste may be worn by girls in 8th grade only

Jewelry - single button or post earring in each ear

Mass Days - shirts must be tucked in during Mass

Phy. Ed. - 5th through 8th grades change for physical education class; t-shirts, pants, and shorts must be loose fitting and meet the length requirements listed above

Designated Non-Uniform Days - Clean, modest, neat, free of rips or tears and messages on clothing must be appropriate; hooded sweatshirts are allowed
