I. Principal Report for Site Advisory Committee

Accreditation Visit

Domain A

Commendations

1. "The school does an excellent job promoting and accomplishing service projects. We were impressed with how many are done, and how they come with a letter that explains the reasoning behind each project, as connected to faith."
2. "We were thrilled to hear that many staff members attend Sunday Mass and many people that we interviewed shared that they feel the school has several great faith role models."
3. "Religion is clearly a priority and focus of the school!. This was apparent in schedules, curriculum resources, and photos."

Recommendations

1. "Post the new Mission statement in more public places like the entrance, gymnasium, etc. and ensure that all of the old versions are replaced in all spaces and all documents." Benchmark 1.4
2. "Have each teachers (other than Religion) set a goal where they integrate the faith into as least one lesson or unit a year" Benchmark 2.5
3. "Schedule at least one faith retreat for all students during the school year where they all attend" Benchmark 3.2
4. "Schedule at least one faith retreat for all staff members during the school year" Benchmark 4.1

1. "Communication from the school to all stakeholders is very effective."

Recommendations

1. "Re-visit the self-study narrative to better align with the Benchmark. We felt it did not address what the Benchmark is asking." Benchmark 6.6 (I believe I wrote this one)
